Materials and Supplies for the Game:

- Blue Band Water Jug- It's imperative that students report in the morning with a FULL water jug!
- Flip Folder and Lyre, complete with all required music and labeling
- Marching Instrument in perfect working condition, with all necessary reeds, oils, etc., and bell mask

Summer Uniform This Week:

- Blue Under Armour Band Shirt (NOT show shirt this week!), Black Badger Band Shorts, Blue Frisco Band Ballcap
- Tennis Shoes with Ankle-height socks (White, black, or gray socks)
- FACE MASK (worn at all times when not actively playing)
- Black gloves for some sections- Horns, Euphoniums, Sousaphones
- LADIES will fix hair in ponytail, if shoulder length or longer
- **GENTLEMEN** must be clean-shaven

6:30-8:00 am Morning Band rehearsal on **JV FIELD** (Including run-through with the Stars!)

- BLT Instructional Leaders report at 6:20 am to line field
- ALL MEMBERS pick up and dispose of tape following rehearsal
- **8:15-8:45 am** Brass- polish instruments- stay off carpeted areas...*Polish job will be part of inspection! (VA students please polish at home)*
 - Front Ensemble- Load Equipment Truck w/ pit crew. Drum Majors bring podiums to truck; plug sound system in for charging inside. (Battery Percussion will load truck at end of 1st period; no pit crew)
- 4:25 pm

 Pre-game Meal in the FHS Cafeteria **All food must stay in the cafeteria, utilizing physically distanced seating in place. For game day meals, no eating in the hallways, rotunda, or band hall. Students, keep the café clean, pick up EVERYTHING from your meal**
 - Virtual Academy Students joining the band for the meal: Arrive ASAP after school and head straight to the cafeteria; bring your instrument and other supplies to the cafeteria with you (for inspection later). Meal service ends at 5:05 pm; we must finish eating by 5:15.
- **5:00-5:15 pm** Dismissal by section for ALL students eating game day meal, to dress into Summer Uniform (see above for uniform guidelines), and report to designated inspection area. Please keep all bathrooms SPOTLESS and picked up, and stay physically distanced:
 - Woodwinds- Auditorium (Presley leads inspection)
 - High Brass- Orchestra Room (Jillian leads inspection)
 - Low Brass- Band Hall (Maadhav leads inspection)
 - Percussion- Choir Room (Dillard leads inspection)
 - Color Guard- Cafeteria (Leikness leads inspection)

5:25-5:35 pm Inspection of Uniform, Instrument, and Supplies (see above for needed supplies and uniform guidelines)

 VA Students who did not join the band for the game day meal will have inspection upon reporting to the stadium. They will bring instruments with them in their vehicles (except for sousaphones and battery percussion). 5:35 pm BUS RIDERS- carry large instruments and Guard equipment out to **BAND SEMI/BOX TRUCK,** for loading by pit crew, then return to inspection area:

- Alternative Transportation Students will take their instruments in their vehicles (except for Sousaphones and Battery Percussion).
- Bus riders' Tenor and Bari Sax, Bass Clarinet, Trombone, Euphonium, Sousaphone- loaded on trucks
- All others will travel in cases on buses with students
- Drum Majors- Ensure sound cart is taken out to truck at this time

5:45 pm Dismissal by section to load buses, or to head out for alternative transportation pick up/ departure

- Bus Riders- Back of the bus loads first; load in order of seating/ Click here for seating charts
- Alternative Transport Students- arrive at stadium in time to check-in by <u>6:15 pm</u>; see <u>this link</u> for instructions
- **5:50 pm** Depart for **Ford Center at The Star.** Click Here for Parking/Drop-Off Instructions, and Directions
- 6:05 pm Arrive, unload buses, and prepare equipment (Carry water jug, flip folder/lyre, wear band ballcap or visor, sunglasses; instrument without case)
 - Students line up in sections; single file, 6 feet apart
 - Alternative Transportation students- Look for one of the directors on site if you arrive before the buses. Assemble with the rest of your section where the band is gathering near the buses/ band truck.
- **6:20 pm** Move to **Sections 107 112**. Await director instructions for seating. Warm-up will take place in the stands.
- **7:15 pm** Be ready for Pregame Sequence! Alma Mater, Fight Song
- 7:30 pm FHS Football Game Begins GO FIGHTING RACCOONS!!!
- **10:30 pm** Approximate end time of game- load and depart.
 - Bus students load large instruments onto truck; board buses
 - Alternative transportation students take ALL items, including instrument, home with you (sousaphones and battery percussion will still be loaded on truck).
- **11:00 pm** Approximate arrival at FHS for bus riders- unload instruments, put away belongings
 - Everyone makes sure that all equipment is brought in and stored properly!
- **11:05 pm** (Approximate) Students are dismissed once all tasks are complete
