Greetings Band and Color Guard families:

First, CONGRATULATIONS on a great start to the 2021-2022 year! The kids have been doing a fantastic job working on Punk'd, and we know the final production will be awesome!

Secondly, thanks to all of you who have been volunteering behind the scenes with meal services, chaperoning, pit crew, photography, and concessions. Your help is invaluable to the success of the band. Quite literally, we could not do it without you.

Thirdly, we find ourselves needing MORE volunteers! The major areas where we are in need are chaperones and pit crew. I know some of you might not be familiar with the roles these groups play, so here's a description for each:

Chaperone – Chaperones help support students to games, during games, and back to the high school.

- Ride the bus with the students to each game
- Hang out in the bleachers with students during the game
- Helping with flip folders on the field during halftime and pit crew if needed
- Ride back to the high school with the students (and taking roll to make sure everyone made it on the bus!)

Pit Crew – Pit Crew is critical to the success of our halftime shows! Eric Warner (<u>pitcrewcaptain@friscobandboosters.com</u>), our pit crew captain, will coordinate your duties. With our Punk'd show, we'll need 20 pit crew members per game/competition. Duties includes the following:

- Loading and unloading the trailer with all the band instruments, equipment, and props (bring work gloves)
- Closer-than-front-row-seating for the halftime show...you're *on the field* helping with instruments and props!
- Grill masters when needed for burger and hot dog preparation

I hope you'll take some time to consider volunteering in one of the critical roles. WE NEED YOUR HELP! October is our busiest month with games and competitions most every weekend (complimentary admission to events when you volunteer in these roles).

Materials and Supplies for the Game:

- Blue Band Water Jug- It's imperative that students report in the morning with a FULL water jug!
- Flip Folder and Lyre, complete with all required music and labeling
- Marching Instrument in perfect working condition, with all necessary reeds, oils, etc.

FULL UNIFORM This Week:

- Dry-Tech Band Shirt, Black Band Shorts, Blue Frisco Band Ballcap or Visor
- Gray Uniform Shoes with Gray Socks (Please do not wear the shoes while walking in the hallways!)
- Uniform Jacket and PUNK sleeves, Gray Uniform Pants, Shako Hats (Pant straps go OVER punk shirt this week)
- LONG HAIR (shoulder length or longer) must be fixed in ponytail or braids for departure. BE PREPARED to fix into bun/ conceal in Shako for halftime
- **GENTLEMEN** must be clean-shaven
- Color Guard Toby will define

6:30-8:00 am Morning Band rehearsal on JV FIELD

- BLT Field Marking Team **B** report at 6:20 am to line field
- ALL BAND MEMBERS pick up and dispose of tape following rehearsal
- **8:15-8:45 am** Brass- polish instruments- stay off carpeted areas...*Polish job will be part of inspection! (Section leaders will assist)*
 - Drum Majors and Equipment Team bring podiums and ladder to truck for loading; plug sound system in for charging inside (loaded after school)
- **1**st **Period** Percussion- Load Equipment Truck w/ pit crew assistance.
- 4:25 pm Pre-game Meal in the FHS Cafeteria for all Band and Color Guard members **All food must stay in the cafeteria- no eating in hallways, rotunda, or band hall. Students, keep the café clean, pick up EVERYTHING from your meal**
- **4:55-5:15 pm** Dress into FULL Uniform (see above for uniform guidelines), and report to designated inspection area. Please keep all bathrooms SPOTLESS and picked up.
 - Woodwinds- Auditorium (Jillian leads inspection)
 - High Brass- Orchestra Room (Emily leads inspection)
 - Low Brass- Band Hall (Maadhav leads inspection)
 - Percussion- Choir Room (Dillard leads inspection)
 - Color Guard- Cafeteria (Leikness leads inspection)
- 5:15-5:25 pm Inspection of Uniform, Instrument, and Supplies (see above for needed supplies and uniform guidelines)

5:25 pm	 Carry large instruments and Guard equipment out to BAND SEMI, for loading by pit crew, then return to inspection area: Tenor and Bari Sax, Bass Clarinet, Mellophone, Trombone, Euphonium, Sousaphone, Percussion-loaded on trucks All others will travel in cases on buses with students Drum Majors- Ensure sound cart is taken out to truck at this time, check for all needed items inside
5:35 pm	All convene in Band Hall for pre-departure meeting
5:40 pm	Dismissal by section to load buses
5:45 pm	Depart for Toyota Stadium
6:00 pm	Arrive, unload buses, and prepare equipment (Carry water jug, flip folder/lyre, shako box; wear band ballcap or visor; instrument without case) • Students line up in sections, single file near buses/truck (DMs and directors will manage)
6:15 pm	Move to AWAY Band seating section. Await director instructions for seating. Warm-up will take place in the stands.
